Wristband System

We are using a wristband system at Magnaball. Wristbands must be worn at all times, even at tea time. Altered wristbands will be invalid.

The General Store

There are several General Stores on site. The main General store is located near the Glurt Institute next to Studio X. They'll provide everything from ice to personal hygiene products to assorted sundries that you may have left at home. Money cannot be used at the General Store, although a synthetic substitute is available. BEER is available for sale in the Concert Field during open hours.

ATM machines + ReCharge Tent area

There are several ATM machines located near the Concert Field, General Store and ReCharge Tent area. Fuel up your critical devices at the ReCharge Tent (and then drain them at the DeCharge Tent).

Info Tents

There is a Main Info Tent in Cluster F, next to Jemp Records, Official Merch, etc. If you need assistance in the campgrounds you may go to one of the security towers located throughout the campgrounds. Security and EMS services are available 24 hours a day throughout the event - please see the map for medical tent locations. Information about towing and locksmith assistance is available at the Info Tent. Lost & Found is located at the Main Info Tent, but it is cleverly hidden.

Day Parking, Exit & Re-Entry

If you are parked in Day Parking you may leave and return during the event. Everyone in your vehicle must have their wristband in order to be readmitted. Your vehicle will be subject to search each time you re-enter the grounds. Day Parking is for just that - camping is not permitted in Day Parking. Vehicles left unattended may be towed, and, in certain instances, toad.

Keep Service Aisles Open

This is the only way we can provide you with fresh water, clean the

toilets, pick up the trash and deliver emergency services. Let the service workers do their job - they're doing it for you! We cannot stress enough how important it is to keep the aisles open in the camping areas for everyone's safety and comfort. Please yield to service vehicles when you are walking.

Accessible Services

Stop by the Access Center for information about services, for assistance or to rest in the shade. It's located just outside the north entrance to the venue, near the Field Hospital. Accessible toilets and restrooms with flush toilets are available throughout the site. A raised viewing platform is reserved for patrons with mobility disabilities. Stop at the Access Center for a wristband. Sign language interpreters will be provided.

Field Hospital & Medical

The field hospital is located just outside the north entrance to the venue, near Accessible Camping. There are EMS tents located throughout the campgrounds - look for the red cross symbols on this page. Lost children will be taken to the nearest medical tent. Flossed children will receive a thumbs-up from their dentist.

Fire

As a safety measure and to keep the air quality high for everyone, there are no open fires allowed. Please use extreme caution with all forms of open flames.

When You Leave

Please be patient and yield to pedestrians as you move out of your camping area and off of the site. Be sure you are well rested, wear your seat belts, and obey the speed limits. Please respect surrounding neighborhoods and don't access blocked areas. Always bet on black.
